Customers will be able **to archive, consult and retrieve all their electronic documents of both a personal and professional nature**, from any location. Particularly useful for customers in the event of an administrative or medical emergency, the online safe deposit system will enable customers to authorize a designated person to access documents in their safe and to enable doctors from Mondial Assistance to provide remote treatment. The Allianz Protect safe deposit box also enables customers to consult useful information on travel, healthcare or a geopolitical situation.

With the increasing move towards **virtual exchanges of information** with public authorities and economic players, companies, administrations and organizations, this innovative digital service can handle **all types of files including photo and video formats.**
